

# John 20 “I have seen the Lord!”

## Mary’s gets to see (v. 1-18)

The stone is removed, the tomb is empty

*1 Cor 15:17 And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. 18 Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost. 19 If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied.*

“I have seen the Lord!”

## Ten Disciples get to see (v.19-23)

*1 Cor 15:20 But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. 21 For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. 22 For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive.*

*24 Then the end will come, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power.*

## Thomas gets to see (v.24-28)
